

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. The examination dates for Higher Malay papers, printed on this schedule, are applicable only to Higher Malay students of the Ministry of Education Language Centre (MOELC).
2. All candidates are to report to the examination venue 15 minutes before the start of each paper. Candidates who are more than 30 minutes late may be barred from the examinations.
3. A candidate who is absent for the examination without a valid reason will get a zero mark. A candidate who reports sick must produce a medical certificate which must reach the Centre within three working days.
4. Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination room until the end of the paper.
5. A candidate may be expelled from the examination room, refused entry for subsequent papers and have their papers cancelled if he/she
 - a. attempts to copy from another candidate or allows his/her answers to be copied by another candidate.
 - b. attempts to obtain unfair assistance or is detected for dishonesty.
6. Candidates are not allowed to have in their possession, while in the examination room, any book, notes or memoranda not authorised for use in the examination.
7. Electronic and communication devices and equipment such as hand phones are not allowed during the examinations.
8. Candidates are to write their answers in dark blue or black ink. All answers written in pencil, including check marks in boxes, will be disregarded.
9. Candidates should be properly attired in their official school uniforms when they present themselves for the examination at the Centre.
10. Candidates should leave the Centre immediately after the examination and not loiter along the corridors or canteen.
