2020 PRELIMINARY EXAMINATIONS SCHEDULE & INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 1. All candidates are to report to the examination venue 15 minutes before the start of each paper. <u>Candidates who are more than 30 minutes late may be barred from the examinations</u>.
- 2. In line with SEAB's examination practice, <u>it is compulsory for candidates to sit for ALL examination components</u>. Components include Oral, Listening Comprehension and the Written Papers. Candidates will be given 'Absent' as examination result for a subject if they are absent from one or more components/papers of that subject without a valid reason or medical certificate.
- 3. A candidate who reports sick must produce a medical certificate which must reach the Centre within three working days from the date of the examination. <u>Candidates will not be given a chance to re-sit the examination if they have missed any part of the examination</u>.

4. <u>Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination room until the end of the paper.</u>

- 5. A candidate may be expelled from the examination room, refused entry for subsequent papers and have his/her papers cancelled if he/she attempts to copy from another candidate or allows his/her answers to be copied by another candidate. This also applies to a candidate who attempts to obtain unfair assistance or is detected for dishonesty.
- 6. Candidates are not allowed to have in their possession, while in the examination room, any book, notes or memoranda not authorised for use in the examination. Electronic and communication devices and equipment such as mobile phones, tablets and smart wrist watches are not allowed during the examinations.
- In line with SEAB's examination practice, candidates are to write their answers clearly in <u>dark blue</u> or <u>black</u> ink. All answers written in pencil, including check marks in boxes, will be disregarded. Candidates are not to use highlighters or correction fluid/ tape as they may affect legibility.
- 8. Candidates must be neatly and properly attired in their official school uniform when they present themselves for the examination at the Centre.
- 9. The examination dates for Higher Malay and Malay (Special Programme) papers printed on this schedule are applicable only to Higher Malay and Malay (Special Programme) students studying at the Ministry of Education Language Centre.
- 10. All classes at the MOELC will be suspended for the duration of the examinations.
